Mathematics Classes

- spiral notebooks (either several 70-sheet or one large 3 subject, to be replenished as needed throughout the year); may be ruled or graph paper—your preference.
- 2-pocket folder (matching color to notebook) for all handouts
- access to a scientific calculator to use at home (\$8-12--look for sin & cos buttons) or free DESMOS app loaded on a cell phone or computer. Algebra and Geometry students may want to upgrade to a *graphing calculator* as we will be using them daily in class and you will use them in high school, too. <u>TI-84 or TI-84 Plus are best</u>. All math classes have graphing calculators to use in class, but students must have at least a scientific calculator available for homework.
- pens & pencils (colors!!)
- glue-stick & box Kleenex to donate to community use
- Geometry: good quality compass, straight-edge, protractor & tracing paper REQUIRED DAILY!
- Algebra/Geometry: Textbooks MUST be covered with either a purchased cover (for a LARGE textbook) or via the paper-bag method—no tape on books! (we can help with this!)
