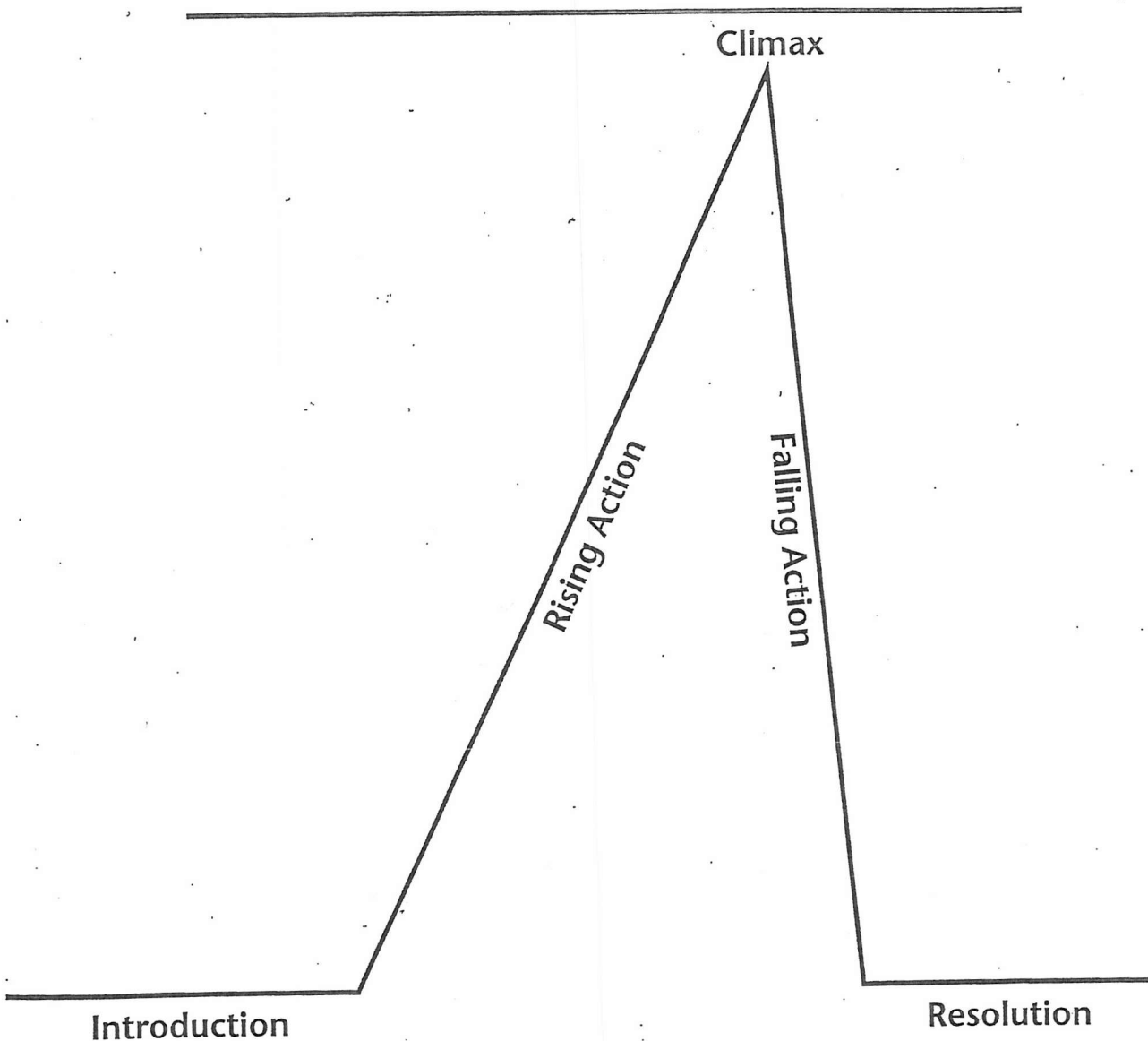

Understanding the Plot of a Story

The plot consists of a beginning, middle, and end. In the beginning the setting and characters are introduced. In the middle we have rising action where a series of events shows the main problem/s in the story. These events lead up to the most important event of the story "The Climax." After the climax there is falling action which leads to the resolution of the problem and the end of the story.
