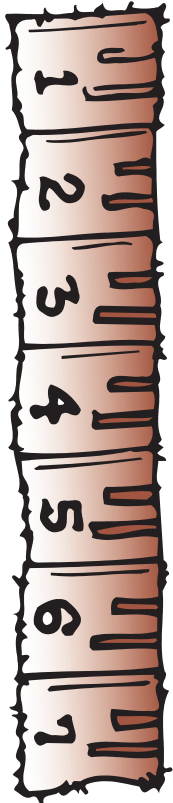

**A.** Alphabetize all the words in a list in your notebook - then copy this alphabetized list two more times in your notebook. (Total = 3 lists)

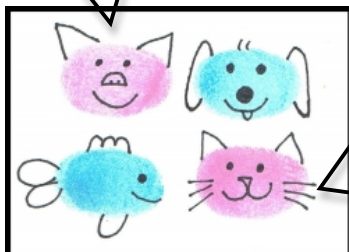
**B.** Write a creative letter to your mom or dad explaining to them how to measure things around your home. (Pretend they don't know how.) Use each of your words at least once in your letter.
